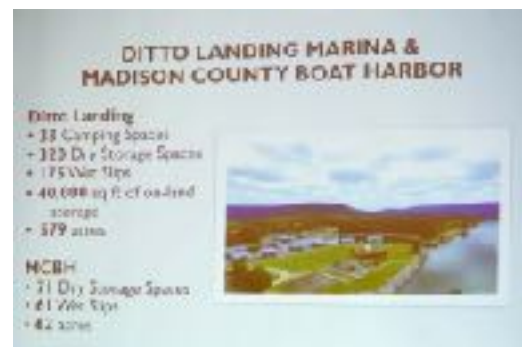

Brandi Quick joined the Ditto Landing Marina & Madison County Boat Harbor as the Executive Director. Their Mission is “The Ditto landing Team welcomes our guests to a safe, clean, family-friendly recreational facility



with our commitment to friendly and quality services.” She has been working to expand the events offered at the landing each year. For example, they recently added a Bar-B-Que Festival. Cooking contestants pay to enter the contest and the public is invited to attend a free music concert and cheer on the BBQ teams. Brandi said the Landing developed a new master plan with the assistance of UAH civil engineering students and events planning from marketing students.

Most events at the Landing are free draw people to the facility and advertise its existence. The finances come from boat slip rentals, camping site rentals, and \$1,500 per month from Madison County. Their goal after the rework in the master plan is to become self sustaining. Renovations include longer slips for larger boats, built-up roads to avoid “extra water” (floods), relocation of the entryway, replacement of the docks and electrical service, and add restrooms.
